BASIC HOBBY COURSE

Admission Process & Eligibility Criteria

The Hobby Course at the Government College of Art & Design, Nagpur is a six-month part-time program designed for individuals who wish to explore their artistic interests in a relaxed and creative environment. Ideal for working professionals, homemakers, retirees, and students, this course offers a joyful and meditative experience focused on self-expression rather than professional training.

Classes are held twice a week (3 hours per day), typically in the evenings or on weekends. Participants receive studio access, expert faculty guidance, and hands-on practice to build foundational skills in the following subjects:

COURSE

Painting– Introduction to materials, color mixing, brush techniques, and basic composition.

Landscape– Study of outdoor scenes, perspective, and natural elements.

Portrait– Basic proportion, facial features, and expression in drawing and painting.

Sculpture– Introduction to clay modeling, basic hand-building techniques, and creating three-dimensional forms.

Printmaking– Introduction to simple printmaking methods such as linocut or monoprint.

Photography– Basics of composition, framing, lighting, and creative visual storytelling

These subjects provide a well-rounded foundation for anyone wishing to reconnect with their creativity and develop a personal art practice.
